Our jumps and throws events went wonderfully, with the weather holding off just enough to let the events proceed. Thank you to the parent volunteers who assisted on the day!



Our key word signs support our Expectation of the Week: I can be safe by wearing my hat outside




## **SCOOTER DONATION - SPESC**


### Making Memories Raffle
